## **Call for Papers / Submission Guidelines**

### **I. Aims and Scope**

The aim of the Journal of National Development Studies (JNDS) is to combine theoretical and practical policy and interdisciplinary research. JNDS welcomes academic paper submissions in the fields of politics, law, sociology, Mainland China studies, and East Asian civilization and culture.

### **II. Call for Papers**

1. JNDS is a refereed biannual periodical published in June and December.
2. JNDS accepts submissions of original research articles, literature reviews, research notes, articles which respond to other authors' works, and review articles (including book and film). The journal does not accept translations. Regular research articles and literature reviews should not exceed 25,000 Chinese characters or 8,000 English words; response articles should not exceed 10,000 Chinese characters or 3,500 English words; research notes should not exceed 15,000 Chinese characters or 6,000 English words; reviews should not exceed 5,000 Chinese characters or 2,000 English words.
3. JNDS accepts both Chinese-language and English-language manuscripts; Chinese-language manuscripts must include a title and abstract in English; English-language manuscripts must include a title and abstract in Chinese.
4. Submissions must meet JNDS's editorial standards (for details, please refer to the website of the NTU Graduate Institute of National Development). When a submitted manuscript does not meet those standards, JNDS may request that the author make revisions to the manuscript before considering it for publication.
5. Copyright of articles published by JNDS is retained by the author;

- however, the author must provide the journal with non-compensatory, non-exclusive license to reproduce and to upload the article to the internet, allowing readers to search for, read, download, and print the article free of charge.
6. JNDS uses a double-blind review process. Manuscripts submitted for review should not contain any reference to the author; submissions must undergo blind review by at least two outside experts and further review by the Editorial Committee before being approved for publication. When necessary, response and review articles will undergo blind review by outside experts following review by the Editorial Committee.
  7. JNDS does not pay royalties for published articles. Contributing authors will be provided with 2 copies of the journal issues in which their articles appeared as well as 20 bound reprints and a full-text pdf of their published articles. Authors whose submissions are not accepted will be sent reviewer opinions for their submissions.

### **III. Submission Procedure**

1. Please submit manuscripts electronically in Word-format via e-mail to the Editorial Committee at [ndjournal99@gmail.com](mailto:ndjournal99@gmail.com); in the e-mail subject line, please type “Journal of National Development Studies Article Submission.”
2. Submissions should include the following items, submitted in the order listed here: title page with author byline (Chinese and English), abstract page (Chinese and English), article text, author’s contact information. ### **IV. Submission Review Principles**

1. Submissions are accepted for review on a year-round, on-going basis.
2. Submissions which do not conform to the aims and scope of JNDS will be rejected.
3. Submissions found to have been published previously or to have

been submitted to multiple publications will be rejected; authors wishing to submit their manuscript elsewhere must first issue a written statement withdrawing their submission to JNDS; submissions which are withdrawn after the review process will be treated as rejected submissions.

4. JNDS reserves the right to decide the period in which a submitted manuscript is published based on editorial requirements.
5. JNDS reviews submitted manuscripts solely for their academic merit; published articles do not represent the views of JNDS.
